ASSISTANT CHOIRMASTER SEARCH

The Assistant Choirmaster should be committed to leading weekly rehearsals, in order to prepare the chorus for its performances alongside the Thunder Bay Symphony Orchestra, which will be conducted by the Symphony Chorus Music Director. In addition, the Assistant Choirmaster will lead a portion or the totality of the choir-alone concert, in collaboration with other conductors (TBD).

The Assistant Choirmaster is not required to play the keyboard.

The Assistant Choirmaster will be mentored by the Symphony Chorus Music Director and the Chorus' pianist. He/she will receive feedback on rehearsal technique, vocal technique and general leadership topics.

(with the exception of November 26 – December 1, conducted by the Symphony Chorus Music Director)

Winter session: January 9 – April 28

(with the exception of February 11 – 14, conducted by the Symphony Chorus Music Director)
