

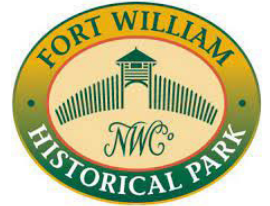

National Inquiry into
Missing and Murdered
Indigenous Women and Girls

May 5th is the National Day of Awareness for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and 2SLGBTQQIA+ Peoples (MMIWG2SLGBTQQIA+). This day is also known as Red Dress Day with respect to Jaime Black's REDress art installation which helped inspire the red dress movement. On May 5th, many people across North America hang red dresses in private and public spaces to remember those who are missing and murdered.

Jeremy Dutcher, keyboard/vocals

Jeremy Dutcher is a Two-Spirit song carrier, composer, activist, ethnomusicologist from Tobique First Nation in Eastern Canada. He gained international acclaim for his album *Wolastoqiyik Lintuwakonawa*, which earned him the 2018 Polaris Music Prize and Indigenous Music Album of the Year at the 2019 JUNO Awards. His musical style blends the songs of his community with neoclassical, jazz, and pop influences, and has led him to collaborate with such iconic artists as Buffy Sainte-Marie and Yo-Yo Ma. Dutcher's work has taken him to the world's great concert halls, NPR's *Tiny Desk*, and the judges' table of Canada's *Drag Race*.



Shy-Anne Hovorka, narrator



Shy-Anne is an award-winning songwriter, multi-instrumentalist, humanitarian and performer, whose first three albums have sold 15,000+ copies worldwide. Numerous songs from the albums received commercial radio airplay across Canada and she inked a lucrative licensing deal for the song "Can't Change The World" in the "Blackstone" TV series. Shy-Anne is also a highly respected motivational speaker whose presentations have inspired thousands of Canadians. Her 2014 album release titled "Bones" captured three 2014 Aboriginal Peoples Choice Music Awards for Best Country Album, Single of the Year (*Be Your Girl*) and Best Album Design. Shy-Anne also won the coveted 2014 APCMA "Entertainer of the Year" award. This groundbreaking album is a testament of her ability to take a listener on a magical journey through multiple genres, moods and emotions.

Thunder Mountain Singers

The Thunder Mountain Singers were created in 1988 in Thunder Bay, Ontario. They are a drum group that has traveled throughout North America and recorded several award winning albums. Thunder Mountain Singers provide services for groups and organizations for hosting events, cultural workshops, Indigenous music consultations, collaboration with artists, and leadership among performing arts and powwow communities.





Cosette Justo Valdés, RBC Featured Conductor

Cosette Justo Valdés is currently the Resident Conductor of the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra. Born and raised in Cuba, as a daughter of amateur musicians, she's loved music all of her life and began learning piano and music theory from age 8. At 18 she saw a symphony orchestra for the first time and immediately knew she wanted to be a conductor. Valdés took up conducting in 2002 at the National Institute of the Arts of Cuba, in Havana, and after graduating in 2009 with a Bachelor's Degree in Orchestral Conducting, she was appointed Music & Artistic Director of the Orquesta Sinfónica de Oriente (OSO) (Santiago, Cuba), Cuba's second-most important orchestra.

Sharon Johnson, speaker

Sharon Johnson, a member of Seine River First Nation, lost her sister in 1992. She works tirelessly to bring awareness to Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women through walks, discussion, advocacy work and sharing her story of her loss, which echoes the loss of so many more.
